Nulife Glass Ltd appoints new Technical Director

CRT recycling company Nulife Glass Ltd has appointed Laurie Wood Msc, C.Env, as Technical Director to oversee development of their recycling facilities and furnace development in Stourbridge, West Midlands. Laurie joins the company from British Standards Institute where he has worked for the last 8 years as an Environmental Specialist.

Laurie said, "This is an exciting new challenge as the service Nulife Glass offers is unique in the UK. None of the CRT glass we process is sent overseas so our customers can have total confidence that their waste won't end up being handled inappropriately in developing countries".

The process developed by Nulife Glass removes the lead from the funnel glass to produce two material streams; clean glass and metallic lead. Both are suitable for re-use in a range of applications". The main focus of the company has been to treat CRTs driven by the requirements of the WEEE Directive however we have also had interest from companies that produce lead crystal products as our process can be used to treat glass waste from their sites as well and convert a hazardous waste into safe, reusable material streams".

The technology used by Nulife Glass is being made available under licence to recycling companies in the UK and across the world and has generated interest from as far a field as Australia and Mexico.
